DIRECTOR STATEMENT

With "Winter Coat" I wanted to explore the theme of motherhood: attempting to illustrate whether the same bond could exist in a relationship devoid of blood ties - two neighbors in this instance. We aren't given the context of their relationship, instead, we step into their lives as voyeurs, listening in on conversations and lurking around corners. As we observe them through their shared experiences, we begin to understand their rapport.

To deconstruct my understanding of motherhood, I looked back on memories shared with my own mother. The moments that ultimately stood out to me the most, were the small, everyday tasks and outings that we did together when I was a child. Moments that at first glance appeared prosaic or uneventful inevitably proved to be my most essential memories of childhood. The aim of the film is to use the mundane to highlight the impact and the beauty of these simple moments; celebrating the ordinary as the backbone of a bond and friendship between two people.
